<b>Summary</b>			
Referred to as "Tuition", this grant would be funded by Youth Connection Charter Schools. The grant amount is determined by "tuition per seat". Olive-Harvey Middle College would receive funds for 189 seats at an allocation of \$7071 per student for a total of \$1,336,419, while Truman Middle College would receive \$1,484,910 for 210 seats at \$7071 per student allocation. This grant would provide support for the middle colleges' entire operational costs including administrative, instructional, and support staff costs. This grant would also provide assistance with instructional supplies, professional development, student activities, and dual enrollment.

This grant is offered in conjunction with the Dropout Retrieval Tuition grant. This grant would be used to supplement and provide support for operational costs. Funding is unrestricted. Olive-Harvey Middle College would receive \$141,750 in funding and Truman Middle College would receive \$157,500 in funding.

<b>Summary</b>			
Chapter 1 or SGSA (Supplemental General State Aid) is a state grant that provides support for low income students (students who qualify for free or reduced lunch). Funding from this grant would be used to provide academic support and remediation, as well as reduce class size, improve attendance, and provide after school enrichment activities. Olive-Harvey Middle College would receive \$117,040 and Truman Middle College would receive 125,400 in grant funds.

**Summary**

Title 1 is a federal grant supported by the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB). This grant supports school improvement initiatives to increase student performance in reading and math so that schools benchmark at an "adequate yearly progress". Funds from this grant would be used to pay a portion of staff salaries (within school improvement) as well as provide professional development, and supplemental student materials in the instructional areas of reading and math. Olive-Harvey Middle College would receive \$28,460 and Truman Middle College would receive \$5,692 in grant funds.

HWC has a Youth Work program that will be a feeder into UIC's new Bachelor Degree in Urban Studies with a concentration in Youth Work. The grant funds would be used to cover the stipends for the faculty time spent on the project.

<b>Summary</b>			
CCC would receive funding for year four of the Highway Construction Careers Training Program at Dawson Technical Institute. Funding would allow the District to recruit and train residents of Chicago for highway construction jobs. CCC project goals include: provide recruiting and marketing; develop and/or utilize training curriculum; conduct training sessions; facilitate placements; provide data entry; adhere to criteria for training validity; and coordinate industry involvement. The college would provide two to five training sessions during the grant period. Each session would consist of 450 hours of highway construction training with a target class size of 60 students.
