RESOLUTION

**ADOPT REVISIONS TO ACADEMIC AND STUDENT POLICIES
OF THE CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO
OFFICE OF STRATEGY AND ACADEMIC GOVERNANCE**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Public Community College Act, as amended, lists the powers and duties of community college districts in the State of Illinois, and states in 110 ILCS 850/3-30, that:

“The board of any community college district has the powers...that may be requisite or proper for the maintenance, operation and development of any college or colleges under the jurisdiction of the Board.”

WHEREAS, the City Colleges of Chicago Academic Policy has been developed to ensure that protocols for training faculty in the City Colleges of Chicago to have the expertise to teach online courses.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois (the "District"), that the City Colleges of Chicago Academic Policy Section 2.15L be revised as indicated in Exhibit A:

Exhibit A has been revised after original submission to the Board to correct the following two items:

1. Addition of the first paragraph "Online Courses Taught for Load" in order to remove specific mention of "Illinois Online Network (ION) Training Courses" in the last sentence.
2. Removal of "ongoing" from the training requirement in the second paragraph "Training Requirements for Teaching Online Courses."
