THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees approves the issuances of a purchase order to Verizon Wireless to provide cellular wireless services from June 5, 2015 through June 30, 2016, at a total cost not to exceed \$45,000.

TERM:

The term of this purchase shall commence no sooner than June 5, 2015 and will continue through June 30, 2016.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Verizon will provide wireless cellular service and mobile wireless hotspots (Mi-Fis) for City Colleges of Chicago employees.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

This solution will allow City Colleges of Chicago employees the ability to stay connected wirelessly providing the ability of these employees to be available at all times when needed.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

The contract being utilized as a part of the joint purchasing agreement has been advertised and awarded in accordance with the procurement procedures of the State of Illinois - Central Management Services for Telecommunication Services through Contract #CMS033559PA.

Pursuant to State law, contracts for goods and from another services procured governmental entity are exempt from the District's Competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Contract Compliance has reviewed the proposed extension and recommends the State of Illinois' MBE/WBE Participation be accepted because this is a joint-purchase. Also, the nature of the services (wireless cellular services) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities provides the basis for a waiver of the Board Approved Participation Plan.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
