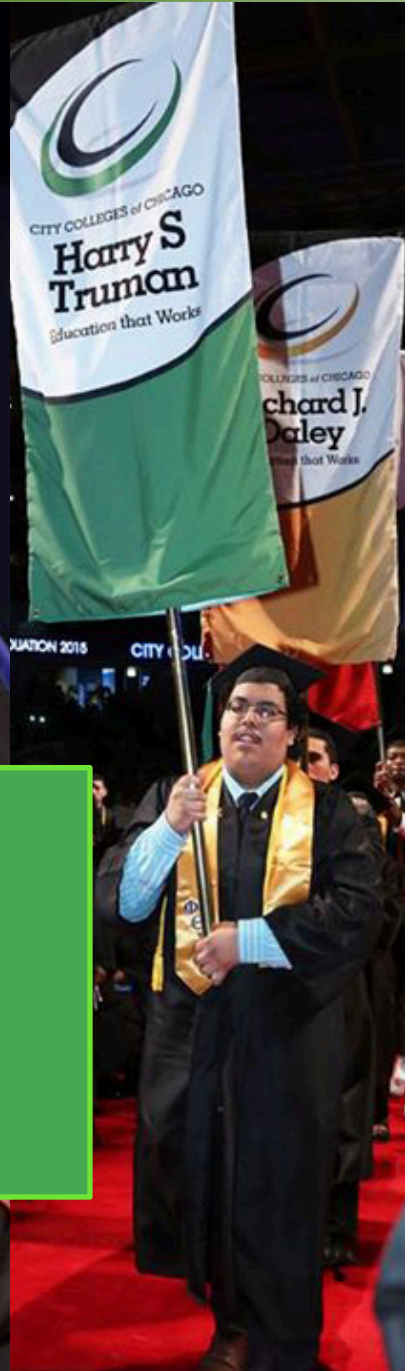

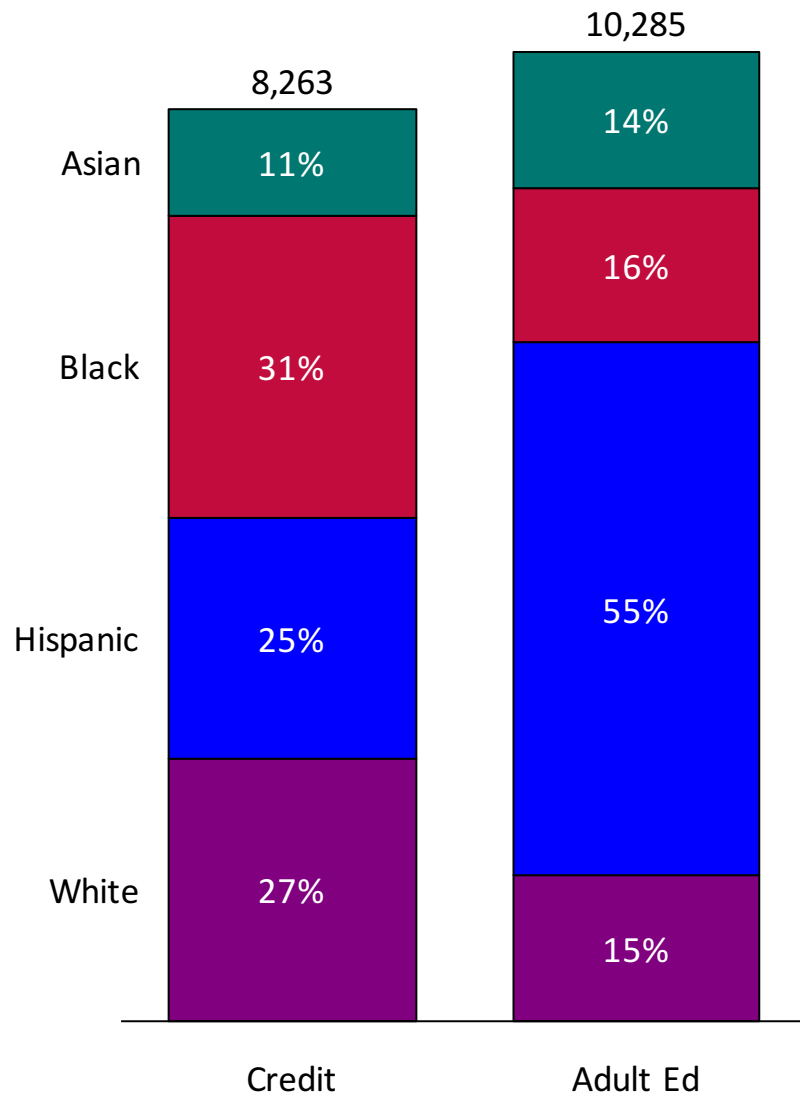

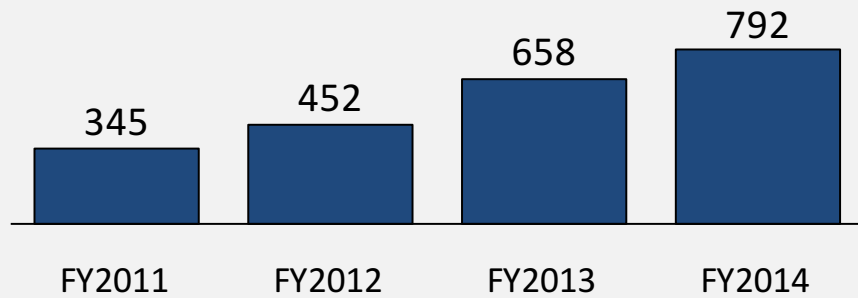

FY2014 Race / Ethnicity Statistics

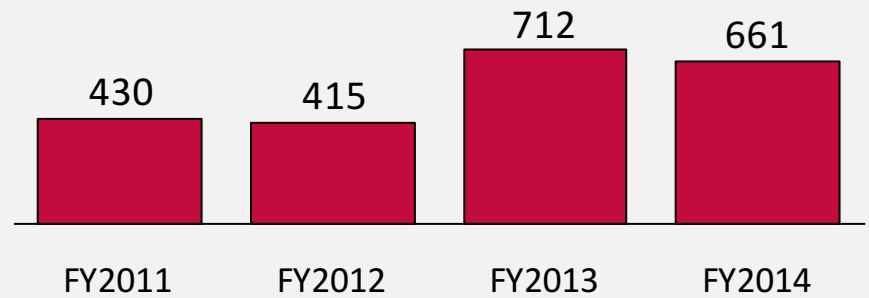

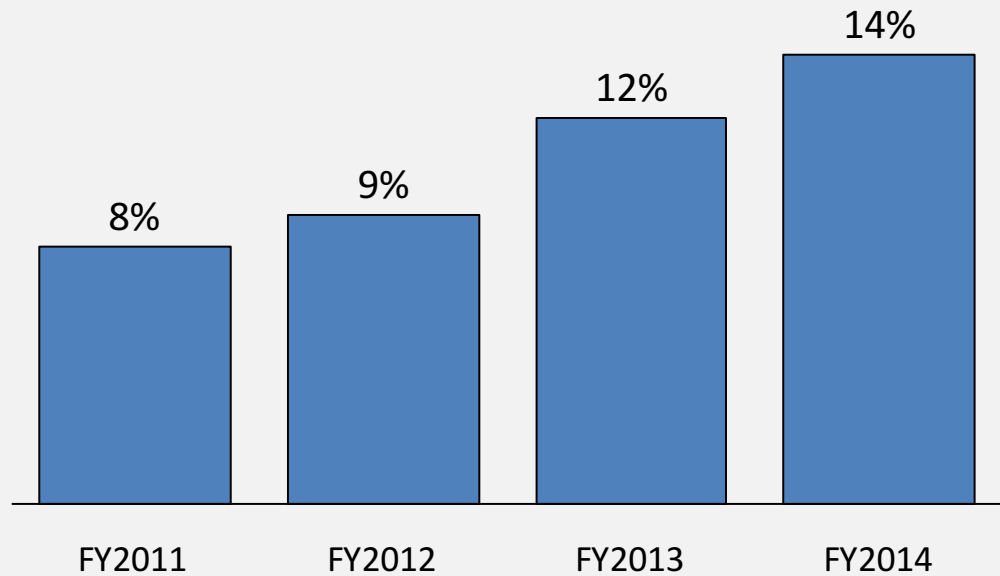

C2C Focus: Education, Human and Natural Sciences

Child Development Programs Transition

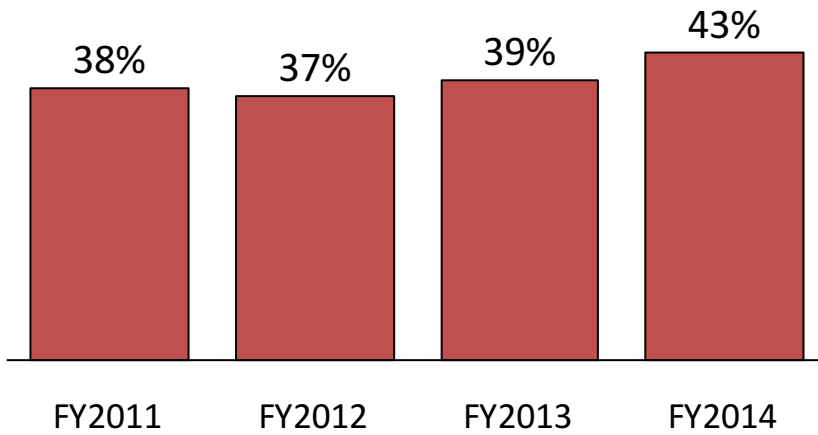
Beginning in Fall 2016, the following programs will be housed exclusively at Truman:

- AAS in Child Development Pre-School

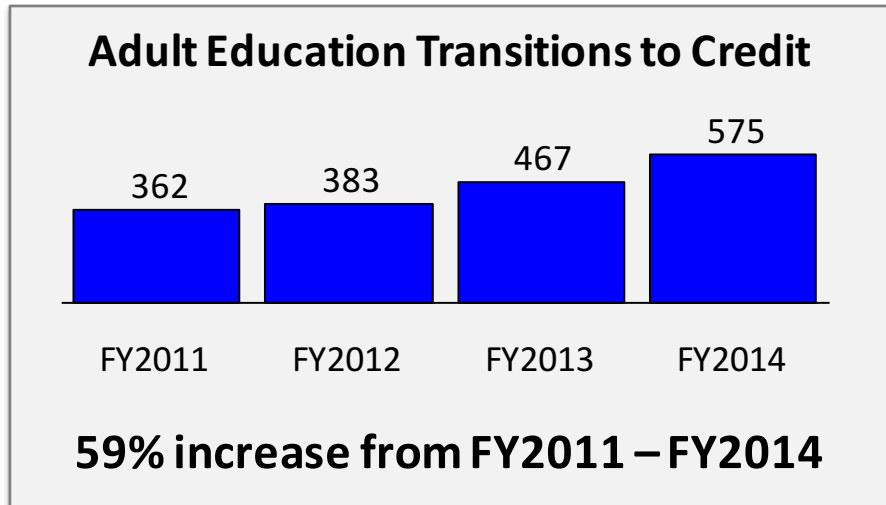
Resources and investments will be consolidated to provide our students with a first-class program and excellent workforce and transfer partners.

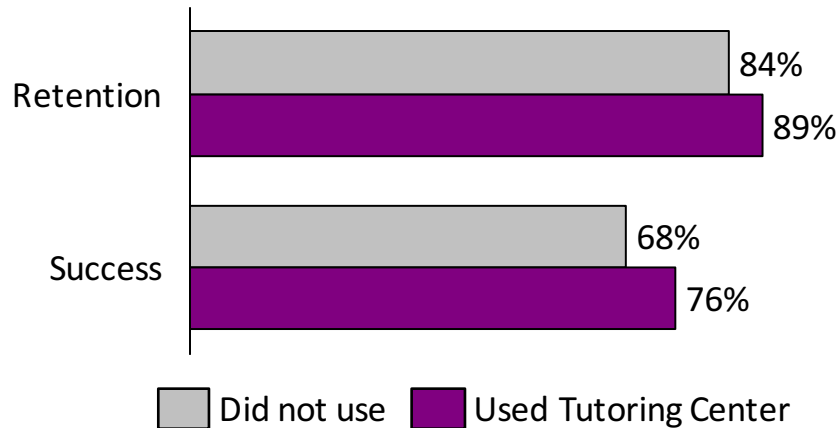

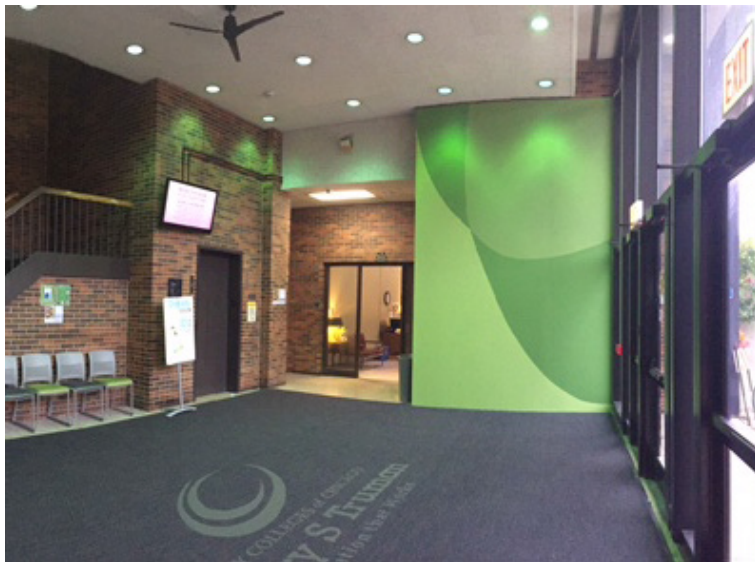
