TERM:

The term of the agreement shall commence no sooner than February 16, 2016 and will continue through February 15, 2017.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Pace Systems, Inc. and CDW-G will sell various IT products and related services to the City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) at pricing derived from RFP KD1501. Products and services include desktops and laptops, monitors, projectors, network equipment, audio/video equipment, various software products, infrastructure equipment services and installation as well as support services for certain hardware and technical services and sales support.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

This solution will authorize CCC to order various IT products and related services at the best available cost based pricing derived from RFP KD1501, which will include manufacturer's discounts, educational software and volume discount incentives.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Specifications prepared by District Office Procurement staff were publicly advertised October 8, 2015 as Request for Proposal (RFP) KD1501. Said RFP was sent to forty-six (46) vendors and a pre-proposal conference was held on October 15, 2015, after which responsive and responsible proposals were received from the following four (4) vendors: 1) CDW-Government, LLC., 2) Netech, 3) Pace Systems, Inc., and 4) Sierra Public Safety Group, LLC. The recommended vendors were selected through a competitive procurement process that evaluated responses in the following areas:

- 1) Proposed plan of action for the execution of the requested scope of services.
- 2) Firm and staff's qualifications and experiences.
- 3) Fees in relation to the Scope of Services.
- 4) Past experience with similar services for educational institutions or government agencies.
- 5) MBE/WBE Compliance plan.

Subsequently, it is recommended that Pace Systems, Inc. and CDW-G both be awarded a contract to provide on an as needed basis computer hardware technology, network equipment, audio/video equipment, various software products and related services for the district. Pace Systems, Inc. will be the primary supplier based on their pricing schedules submitted and CDW-G will be the secondary supplier. This will ensure that the District has the most competitive pricing solutions.
