#### I. <u>CALL TO ORDER SPECIAL BOARD MEETING</u>

#### III. <u>WELCOME</u>

Chair Massey welcomed everyone by noting that this would be the last Board Meeting held at 226 W. Jackson Boulevard. The Chair acknowledged and thanked all staff involved in the moving process, expressing that the Board was looking forward to holding the remainder of the 2018 Board meetings at Harold Washington College.

The Chair also mentioned the positive editorial in the Chicago Tribune from earlier in the week that highlighted the Star Scholars Program.

# VI. <u>CHANCELLOR'S UPDATES</u>

Chancellor Salgado began by reflecting on the flexibility of District Office employees during the process of the move from 226 W. Jackson, noting the shifts that have had to be made in their daily lives such as commutes and child care. The Chancellor thanked the staff at District Office for their dedication, and noted that the last group of District employees would be moving out of 226 W. Jackson to Dawson Technical Institute during the next week.

The Chancellor took the time to note the changes and improvement at Dawson in regards to physical spaces, such as the career services area, students' commons area, and the new library.

Moving on, Chancellor Salgado spoke about the ongoing leadership searches. He noted that the Board would be considering the appointments of three permanent presidents – Dr. Gregory Thomas for Kennedy-King College, Interim President Ignacio Lopez for Harold Washington College, and Interim President David Sanders for Malcolm X College. The Chancellor also thanked outgoing Interim President Craig Lynch for his service at Kennedy-King College and greater City College community in his previous roles.

Chancellor Salgado also recognized Interim President Felicia Davis, not in attendance, for her service at Olive-Harvey College, noting her new role as a senior advisor for the Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics Center. The Chancellor also noted Malcolm X Interim Vice President Kimberly Hollingsworth's transition into the role of Interim President of Olive-Harvey College.

The Chancellor briefly mentioned enrollment, noting the strong early numbers in enrollment growth heading into the fall.

Finally, the Chancellor noted an event he attended the previous night at Sarah Goode Academy, Daley College's early college partner. The Chancellor noted that he and President Garza met with eighteen young people graduating from high school with an associates degree from Daley College. Chancellor Salgado urged the room to celebrate the work being done in early college programs and dual credit and dual enrollment programs.
