The term of the agreement shall commence on July 1, 2018, and will continue until terminated in writing by the General Counsel.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

Axiom Global will provide the follow services: Axiom will provide CCC with attorneys to provide legal services which the General Counsel deems necessary.

**BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:**

The Office of the General Counsel has determined that it would be in the best interest of the District to move forward with Axiom Global as the provider of temporary legal services for the District.

**MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:**

The Office of Contract Compliance has reviewed the proposed agreement and recommends a waiver of the Board Approved Participation Plan due to the nature of the services (legal staffing) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Inspector General—It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General’s authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics—It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board’s Ethics Policy, adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability—Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
