# III. REMARKS FROM CHAIR MIDDLETON

institution on their way to further college study or careers in more timely and efficient ways. Chancellor Hyman thanked the faculty and staff who have worked on Reinvention over the past several years. Chancellor Hyman thanked the college presidents for their service and the board for the opportunity to serve.
