CAREMARK LLC  
OFFICE OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND STAFF DEVELOPMENT  
(AMENDMENT TO BOARD REPORT #33603, ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 1, 2018)  
DISTRICT WIDE

**THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:**

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreements, to execute an amendment to the agreement with Caremark LLC to continue to manage the District’s prescription drug plan under the District PPO Medical Plan for the period from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021, at a total cost not to exceed \$7,000,000 annually.

**ORIGINAL TERM:**

The term of this agreement will commence January 1, 2019 and end on December 31, 2020.

**AMENDED TERM:**

The term of this agreement will commence January 1, 2019 and end on December 31, 2021.

**BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:**

The Caremark LLC contract will offer CCC savings of approximately \$1.4 million, \$263,000 related to drug pricing and \$1.2 million related to rebates.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) will retain Caremark to manage the prescription drug plan under the CCC PPO Medical Plan.

**VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:**

All Sister Agencies participated in the City Healthcare Coalition Request for Proposal (“RFP”) process. Members of the Coalition include: City of Chicago, Chicago Public Schools, Chicago Park District, Chicago Housing Authority, Chicago Transit Authority, and the City Colleges of Chicago, which are sometimes referred to individually as an Agency or Municipal Agency, and collectively as the Agencies. Specifications were prepared by the City of Chicago Procurement Staff and were publicly advertised on February 23, 2018 as Request for Proposal CBO 2018-001.

On February 23, 2018, the above referenced request for proposal (the “RFP”) entitled “Request for Proposal for Pharmacy Benefits Manager” was advertised by the City of Chicago (the “City” or the “Lead Agency”) on behalf of itself and the Chicago Park District, Chicago Transit Authority, City Colleges of Chicago, Active Employees - Cook County, Illinois (“Cook County”), and the Officers’ Annuity and Benefit Fund of Cook County and Forest Preserve District Employees’ Annuity and Benefit Fund of Cook County (the “Cook County Pension Fund”), (which are sometimes referred to individually as an Agency or a Municipal Agency, and collectively as the Agencies).

Competitive bids were obtained from five (5) vendors. The Coalition Evaluation Committee individually scored each RFP submitted. Four vendors were selected as finalists and were invited for oral presentations: (1) Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois, (2) Envision, (3) Caremark and (4) Optum. On April 23, 2018, additional information was requested from the four finalists. Information was received and reviewed by the Agencies and none of the finalists were eliminated from further consideration prior to oral presentations. On May 10 and 14, 2018, oral presentations were made to the Committee by the four finalists. Subsequently, the Committee discussed the presentations. A request was made on May 31, 2018 for finalist price improvement with a deadline of June 4, 2018. Responses were received from all proposers by the deadline except Optum. The Agencies submitted final evaluation scores that included consideration of the improved pricing on June 6, 2018. An Evaluation Committee meeting was held on June 8, 2018 to review the composite final evaluation scores at which time the Committee unanimously determined that it would recommend Caremark as the selected vendor.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
