WHEREAS, Diane Minor has served as the Vice Chancellor of Administrative and Procurement Services of the City Colleges of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Minor retired from the City Colleges of Chicago in June 2019 after fourteen years of service to the District; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Minor began her service at City Colleges in 2005 as the District Director of Procurement and Business Services and became the Associate Vice Chancellor in 2006, followed by her promotion to Vice Chancellor of Administrative and Procurement Services in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Minor oversaw the renovation of numerous facilities and the construction of new campuses at Kennedy-King College and Malcolm X College, the McKeon Building at Harry S Truman, and the construction of the Manufacturing Technology and Engineering Center at Daley College and the Transportation Distribution Logistics Center at Olive-Harvey College; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Minor revised the District's Minority-Owned Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (WBE) Participation Plan and set the benchmark for meeting the goals of 25% (MBE) and 7% (WBE), and established the automated the reporting process; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Minor's service and leadership was exemplified by consummate professionalism, collaboration, and commitment and dedication to the mission and values of the City Colleges of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, outside of her professional career, Ms. Minor has served the City of Chicago through her deep involvement with community organizations such as the Better Boys Foundation, the Museum of Science and Industry, YMCA Camp Pinewood, and the South Side Community Arts Center.
