RESOLUTION TO SET TUITION FOR BOARD PROGRAMS OFFICE OF FINANCE DISTRICT WIDE

WHEREAS, the Illinois Public Community College Act (110 ILCS 805/3-45) authorizes a Community College Board to require tuition; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.3 of the Board Bylaws of City Colleges of Chicago provides for the adoption of policies and states that:

“The Board may adopt, from time to time, policy statements, guidelines, procedures, regulations, collective bargaining agreements, codes of conduct, or similar documents issued for the governance of the Board, the District and the Colleges.”

WHEREAS, the Chancellor charged a Tuition Review Committee inclusive of faculty, administrators, staff, and students with developing recommendations for tuition changes. That Committee held two open forums at each of the seven City Colleges between November 2019 and March 2020 and utilized input and feedback from those open forums to shape its recommendations. The committee balanced principles of affordability and fairness with the imperative of ensuring a stable long-term budget outlook and the ability for City Colleges of Chicago to maintain quality educational programs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has previously approved, adopted and now seeks to amend such tuition and fees; and

WHEREAS, tuition for credit classes will be charged at a constant credit hour per the chart below. Pre-credit classes shall continue to be calculated at one half the rate of full credit classes:

WHEREAS, the Tuition Review Committee recommended: 1) an annual increase in per-credit hour tuition of 3% beginning in fiscal year 2021 through fiscal year 2024 and 2) fees on high-cost courses. Those recommendations are delayed due to the nature of the current COVID-19 crisis and will be considered in future years; and

WHEREAS, specialized tuition for health care programs at Malcolm X College, along with course-retake tuition for those programs, with summer course tuition charged at the course-retake rate, shall be:

WHEREAS, tuition for the specialized programs of Gas Utilities Workers Program and Overhead Electrical Line Workers Program at Kennedy-King College have tuition rates established by partnership agreements with, respectively, People’s Gas and ComEd, and those tuition rates will remain consistent with those agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the aforementioned revisions to tuition shall be adopted by the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, as of April 2, 2020 and effective beginning with the Summer 2020 term.
