ORIGINAL TERM:

The original term of the agreement for the delivery of meals commenced on May 3, 2018 and ends on May 2, 2019 with options to renew for four (4) one-year periods

RENEWAL TERM:

The second renewal term of the agreement shall commence no sooner than May 3, 2020 and will continue through May 2, 2021 with two (2) remaining options to renew for one (1) one-year period each.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Fooda, Inc. will provide the following services:

Childcare meals at Daley College, Malcolm X College, Olive-Harvey College, and Truman College

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

Services provided will ensure the provided childcare meals to CCC child development laboratories are compliant with Illinois State Board of Education - Child and Adult Care Food Program requirements.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Specifications were prepared by District Procurement staff in accordance with the State Board of Education requirements and Bid #MWJ1801A was publicly advertised on January 4, 2018. Twenty Three (23) firms were notified of the solicitation. A pre-bid meeting was conducted at Malcolm X College on January 11, 2018. Three (3) firms responded to the bid on February 20, 2018: 1) Compass Group USA, Inc. dba Canteen, Inc.; 2) Fooda, Inc.; and 3) Taher, Inc. a summary of the bids is below:
