- **USER:** All Eligible Employees, Retirees, and their dependents

TERM:

The term of this agreement shall commence on January 1, 2021 and shall continue through December 31, 2021.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

BCBS provides self-insured dental claims administration services for eligible active and retired employees of CCC.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

It is advantageous to the District to leverage the joint purchasing agreement with the City of Chicago. The current agreements stem from RFP Specification No. 13-250046. The City of Chicago's current agreement consolidated the provider pool thus providing cost savings on the administrative fees while maintaining the "best in class services.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

The contract being utilized as part of the joint purchasing agreement has been advertised and awarded in accordance with the procurement procedures of the City of Chicago Procurement

staff specification #13-250046. Pursuant to State law, contracts for goods and services procured by another governmental entity are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.
