RESOLUTION

**AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION (CDOT)
OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND PROCUREMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220 et seq., as amended, authorizes public agencies to enter into agreements and contracts to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking authorized by law upon approval of their respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT) is responsible for responsible for public way infrastructure, including planning, design, construction, maintenance and management and CDOT works to rebuild and renew this system by resurfacing and reconstructing miles of arterial and residential streets, building and maintaining hundreds of miles of sidewalks, and resurfacing dozens of alleys each year; and

WHEREAS, the District is responsible for resurfacing Adams Street following the completion of the construction of the current Malcolm X College campus (pursuant to Chapter 10-20, 10-30, and Section 2-120-300 of the City of Chicago Municipal Code) and has determined that it is desirable, advantageous and in the public interest to undertake the project to restore Adams Street adjacent to Malcolm X College under the City Colleges of Chicago's Capital Improvement Program in conjunction with CDOT and therefore an intergovernmental agreement which delineates the objectives, duties and responsibilities of CDOT and the Board are necessary; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the City Colleges of Chicago, County of Cook and State of Illinois, authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such an agreement, to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Department of Transportation to repair and repave Adams Street adjacent to Malcolm X College for a total cost not to exceed \$267,523.59.
