This program will fund approximately 180 socially distanced raised community garden boxes that will be placed directly on top of a former Olive-Harvey College employee compacted gravel parking lot to reduce storm water run-off. OHC has a community garden committee comprised of faculty, staff and administrators who will be tasked with the operations of the garden. Students, faculty, and as well as the community will manage their own garden beds. The community gardens will benefit students, faculty and staff and allow for more visitors to come to the campus to participate in fresh food and produce.

#### Summary

This is a new grant for the District. The purpose of this grant is closing gaps in student outcomes within CCC, with a particular emphasis on supporting Black students, who make up approximately 27% of CCC's student body. CCC will develop the infrastructure, strategies, and tools to achieve unprecedented and equitable student outcomes, putting CCC on-track to narrow its equity gaps by a third by 2025 and close them entirely by 2032. The funds will be used for new dashboards to help CCC better harness equity data, a training plan to seed continuous improvement champions across CCC, and an innovative microgrant program to rapidly test new strategies and identify what works for transfer or scale.
