RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGRREEMENT WITH THE ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD) AND WILBUR WRIGHT COLLEGE

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5ILCS 220 et seq., as amended authorizes public agencies to enter into agreements and contracts to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking authorized by law upon approval of their respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Community College Board will partner with Wilbur Wright College to provide services including, but not limited to recruitment, tuition, short term training, tutoring, career exploration and employment placement increasing career opportunities for African-Americans entering employment earning 30% above the regional living wage.

WHEREAS, Wilbur Wright College will manage and administer the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Community College Board will provide up to \$1,145,030.20 for operating costs during fiscal years 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such an agreement, to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Illinois Community College Board and Wilbur Wright College to provide training for up to 125 qualified participants, for the period of December 1, 2021 through December 31, 2022, in which the Illinois Community College Board agrees to provide up to \$1,145,030.20 for use in connection with the program.
