THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

That the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreements, to enter into an agreement with Purpose Workforce Solutions L3C and Chatham Business Association to provide student support services including, counseling, case management, coaching and mentoring for the period commencing no sooner than April 7, 2022 through December 31, 2022, at a total not to exceed cost for each vendor listed below. The Board authorizes a total appropriation for all agreements not to exceed cost of \$183,000.

TERM:

The term of the purchase will commence no sooner than April 7, 2022and will end on December 31, 2022.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The vendors listed above will be providing student wrap around supports including coaching, mentoring, case management and employment support services.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

The vendors listed above are included as sub-grantees in the Richard J. Daley College ICCB 2022 Workforce Equity Grant Award. In accordance with the sole source policy and procedures, this purchase is exempt from the District's competitive bidding process.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the above referenced purchase request and recommends a waiver of the Board Approved Participation Plan due to the nature of the purchase (student support services).

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
