**RESOLUTION**

**AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH  
THE ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD AND CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO  
OFFICE OF ACADEMIC AND STUDENT AFFAIRS  
DISTRICT WIDE**

**WHEREAS**, The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5ILCS 220 et seq., as amended authorized public agencies to enter into agreements and contracts to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking authorized by law upon approval of their respective governing bodies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Community College Board will partner with City Colleges of Chicago to support and expand Transitional Math and English language instruction and curriculum development to high school seniors in our partner high schools with Chicago Public Schools. The ICCB, in partnership with the City Colleges of Chicago will support the access of regional training opportunities, identify scalable and sustainable models of program delivery, support the development of curricular resources and evaluate program effectiveness.

**WHEREAS**, City Colleges of Chicago will manage and administer the program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Community College Board will provide \$25,000 to support program implementation.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such an agreement, to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Illinois Community College Board and City Colleges of Chicago to provide support and expansion to Transitional Math and English from the period of January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022, in which the Illinois Community College Board agrees to provide \$25,000 for use in connection with the program.
