RESOLUTION

**AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE
ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD AND KENNEDY-KING COLLEGE**

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5ILCS 220 et seq., as amended authorizes public agencies to enter into agreements and contracts to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking authorized by law upon approval of their respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Community College Board will partner with Kennedy-King College to provide services including, but not limited to the connection of African American and low-socioeconomic students to employment through effective employer engagement. The ICCB, in partnership with the Workforce Equity Initiative (WEI) consortium of colleges, proposes to develop a strategy to strengthen the connection of WEI students, the African American population in particular, to employment opportunities within their communities.

WHEREAS, Kennedy-King College will manage and administer the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Community College Board will provide up to \$35,000.00 for operating costs during fiscal year 2022-2023.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such an agreement, to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Illinois Community College Board and Kennedy-King College to provide training, for the period of May 1, 2022 through August 31, 2023, in which the Illinois Community College Board agrees to provide up to \$35,000.00 for use in connection with the program.
