that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreements, to execute a renewal agreement with Caremark, LLC to manage the District’s prescription drug plan under the District PPO Medical Plan for the period from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, at a total administrative fee cost not to exceed \$9,000,000 annually.

ORIGINAL TERM

The original term of this agreement began on January 1, 2019 and will continue through December 31, 2021.

AMENDED ORIGINAL TERM:

The original term of this agreement began on January 1, 2019 and will continue through December 31, 2021, with two (2) options to renew for one (1) year each.

FIRST RENEWAL TERM:

The first term of the renewal agreement shall commence on January 1, 2022 and end on December 31, 2022, with (1) option remaining to renew for one year each.

SECOND RENEWAL TERM:

The second and final term of the renewal agreement shall commence on January 1, 2023 and end on December 31, 2023.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The Caremark, LLC contract will offer CCC savings of approximately \$1.5 million, \$270,000 related to drug pricing and \$1 million related to rebates.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) will retain Caremark to manage the prescription drug plan under the CCC PPO Medical Plan.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

The contract being utilized as part of the joint purchasing agreement has been advertised and was awarded in November, 2018 in accordance with the procurement procedures of the City of Chicago (Specification No. CBO 2018-001).
