**RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING A COLLABORATION AND FACILITIES USE LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH
CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS
KENNEDY-KING COLLEGE**

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5ILCS 220/1 et seq., as amended, authorizes public agencies to enter into agreements and contracts to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking authorized by law upon approval of their respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, Chicago Public Schools (CPS) and Kennedy-King College desire to collaborate to encourage and facilitate enrollment of students in the CPS Student Outreach and Re-Engagement (SOAR) program into Kennedy-King College programs; and

WHEREAS, CPS SOAR and Kennedy-King College will work together to develop policies, protocols, and procedures to smooth the transition of CPS students in SOAR workshops into Kennedy-King College Adult Education and certification programs, to include but not limited to co-developing post-secondary plans, guiding CPS students on completing and submitting items required for enrollment at Kennedy-King, and sharing career exploration and financial aid information; and

WHEREAS, Kennedy-King College will provide CPS SOAR with the use of office space and two (2) classrooms for high school credit recovery, social emotional reengagement workshops, and referral to dual enrollment, GED, and other post-secondary opportunities at Kennedy-King College; and

WHEREAS, CPS shall compensate Kennedy-King College \$54,340 annually for the use of such office and classroom space;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois hereby authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreement, to execute a collaboration and shared facility use agreement with Chicago Public Schools for the period of December 1, 2022 through November 30, 2024.
