RESOLUTION

**AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT
OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO
OFFICE OF ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT**

WHEREAS, The Illinois Department Of Juvenile Justice (IDJJ) operates Illinois Youth Center – Chicago (the “Facility”), a secure correctional facility for youth ages 13-21 committed to IDJJ’s custody; and CCC is a community college located in Chicago, Illinois; and CCC and IDJJ seek to partner to provide access to online college courses to youth at the Facility who meet CCC’s enrollment criteria; and

WHEREAS, The Recitals set forth above are incorporated into this agreement as if fully set forth herein. The Facility shall refer youth for course enrollment and may remove youth from the course in accordance with Department policies and procedures. CCC shall facilitate placement testing, registration, and enrollment in courses. CCC and the Facility shall agree on a limited number of courses for youth enrollment based on youth placement tests and Facility capacity to facilitate participation. The Facility will provide supervised computer and internet access to facilitate class participation. Facility staff will be present in the room during all class sessions. The Parties agree that youth enrollment shall be allowed to continue when youth are released from custody to aftercare and/or returned to custody; and

WHEREAS, Funding for programming, CCC shall provide guidance to eligible youth in submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). IDJJ shall provide funding for any tuition or fees not covered by FAFSA, at the City of Chicago Resident rate of \$147 per credit hour. CCC shall issue IDJJ an itemized invoice for each semester’s tuition and fees. IDJJ shall remit payment to CCC in accordance with its payment procedures. In the event youth obtain grant funding through Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which covers any part of their tuition or fees, CCC shall issue a refund in the amount of such grant funding to IDJJ or make a credit toward future IDJJ student costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, in consideration of the foregoing matters and mutual obligations of the Parties, the Parties hereby agree as follows:
