THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees amends Board Report 33776 to (i) authorize an increase of \$2,484,000 in aggregate spending so that the total cost spent with the seventeen vendors set forth below shall not exceed \$15,484,000 from June 1, 2019 through June 30, 2024, instead of the prior \$13,000,000 maximum, and (ii) authorize the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreements, to amend the existing agreements with each of the vendors set forth below to reflect the new \$15,484,000 aggregate maximum, if determined necessary by the General Counsel.

DISTRICT ACTIONS: In order to further address matters related to this Agreement as described in Board Report 34918 dated June 1, 2023, (i) the Compliance Officer/Director of Risk Management and the Procurement Department shall implement live training for the Office of Information Technology to reiterate Procurement processes, post RFP requirements, signing authority and the required legal review of

agreements; and (ii) the Procurement Department is conducting a review of all OIT agreements to ensure compliance with applicable RFPs, bid recaps and sole source agreements.

USER: District Wide

TERM:

The term of this agreement commenced on July 1, 2019, and end on June 30, 2024, with an option to renew for an additional two (2) two-year periods.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Provide the District with IT-related professional consultant(s) to support various CCC departments, projects, and initiatives. These vendors provide professional services for the implementation, upgrade, and maintenance of critical IT systems (e.g., Human Resources, Financials, Student Finances, Financial Aid, Payroll, Customer Relationship Management. Benefits, Compensation, Recruiting, Websites, Portal, Network Infrastructure, Security, ID Cards, etc.) related to student, staff, and/or faculty onboarding, development, enrollment, completion, retention, productivity and efficiency.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

These agreements include pre-negotiated vendor rates for the consultant(s) that are competitive and at or below market rates (on average). The vendors chosen have experience working in Public Sector/Higher Education organizations, possess knowledge of current and/or emerging technologies, and are selected based on proven capabilities to provide the appropriate qualified skilled resources quickly.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to Board Report #33776, specifications were prepared by District Procurement staff and publicly advertised on May 6, 2019, as Request for Proposal (RFP) #SJ1902 – Technical Staff Augmentation Services. The RFP was sent to fifty (50) firms and a pre-proposal conference was conducted on May 10, 2019. Submittals were received on May 20, 2019, from twenty-three (23) vendors.

The firms were evaluated according to the following criteria:

- 1. Sourcing Process Ability to provide timely, diverse, and quality resources for the job functions or services requested.
- 2. Firm Experience and Qualifications Quality, thoroughness, and clarity of proposal.
- 3. Acceptance of CCC Contract Terms and Conditions.
- 4. Costs/Value-Adds
 - a. Rates
 - a. Discounts (duration, quantity, longevity, etc.)
 - b. Option to Hire (temp to permanent, hiring options)
- 5. MBE/WBE Compliance plan

Based on the initial review and evaluation ratings the following seventeen (17) vendors were recommended to be a part of the pre-qualified pool: 1. Bourntec Solutions, 2. Clarity Partners, 3. Comtec Information, 4. Sntial Technologies Inc., 5. DTI, 6. SDI Solutions LLC, 7. Nectel 8. Level One, 9. GNC, 10. 22ndCentury Technologies, 11. ERP Analysts Inc., 12. RLC, 13. Viva USA, Inc., 14. Senyro, 15. IYKA, 16. The William Everett Group, and 17. Experis.

As part of this procurement process, Maetech, Essani International, Inc., Swoon Group, V Tech Solutions, OculusIT, LLC, and Globalpundits are deemed non-responsive because of their failure comply with their MBE/WBE plan submission as stated in the RFP documents.

The recommended pool of 17 vendors will be contacted and provided a Statement of Work (SOW) for the requested project. As we are considering a project resource, we will consider both skills and pricing in the selection. Pricing was based on the vendor's submitted proposal response to the RFP. The hourly rate for the required position will be limited to the cost proposed in the original RFP response, cannot be increased during the life of the contract period and is inclusive of all costs.
