RESOLUTION TO SET TUITION FOR BOARD PROGRAMS THE OFFICE OF ACADEMIC AFFAIRS AND STUDENT SERVICES (Amendment to Board Report 34915) DISTRICT WIDE

WHEREAS, the Illinois Public Community College Act (110 ILCS 805/3-45) authorizes a Community College Board to require tuition; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.3 of the Board Bylaws of City Colleges of Chicago provides for the adoption of policies and states that:

"The Board may adopt, from time to time, policy statements, guidelines, procedures, regulations, collective bargaining agreements, codes of conduct, or similar documents issued for the governance of the Board, the District and the Colleges."

WHEREAS, in the interest of a seamless student experience and an institutional commitment to continuous improvement, the offices of Finance and Academic and Student Affairs reevaluated the processes by which students are charged in specialized healthcare programs and found that restructuring the mechanism by which students are charged for these programs to a per-credit hour rate rather than a flat rate could create pricing transparency and operational efficiencies without changing the total program cost for students; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has previously approved, adopted and now seeks to amend such tuition and fees; and

WHEREAS, per the current tuition for credit classes will be continue charged at a constant credit hour per the chart below. Pre- credit classes shall continue to be calculated at one half the rate of full credit classes:
