### **Executive Summary**

#### **Fall 2023 Total Enrollment Benchmarking**



- ICCB Total Headcount (Credit and Adult Education combined) district for Fall 2023 increased 12.7% (4,426 students) compared to last fall, double the state average and nearly double the national average.
- All seven colleges experienced an increase in total headcount enrollment from last year.

#### **Fall 2023 Enrollment Highlights**



- Credit headcount at census date was up 8% in Fall 2023 compared to the prior year's census headcount.
- Adult Education headcount at census date was up 27% in Fall 2023 compared to the prior year's census headcount
- New student enrollment increased 12% and continuing student enrollment increased by 16%.

 CCC surpassed the Fall enrollment performance management target of a 30% admitted to enroll yield rate, contributing to new and stop-in student enrollment growth





## CCC's ICCB Census Headcount Enrollment increased 12.7% compared to last fall





CCC Fall enrollment growth of 12.7% exceeded the Illinois community college average of +5.7%






# Credit headcount at Census date was up 8% in Fall 2023 compared to the prior year's Census headcount

Census Date Unduplicated Credit Headcount by Home College, Fall 2022 - Fall 2023









# CCC outpaced 2-year public colleges nationally in undergraduate enrollment this fall


#### Fall 2023 YOY Undergraduate Enrollment Change by Campus Setting - Nationally





## New student enrollment increased 13% and continuing student enrollment increased by 16%


Census Date Unduplicated Credit Headcount by Student Type and Home College, Fall 2022 - Fall 2023



New = first time in credit at CCC, including Early College; Continuing students were retained from the prior term, returning students have enrolled at CCC in the past, but been out for at least one big term.




## Enrollment for Black and Latinx male students increased dramatically in the last year, surpassing state and national trends



- enrollment at public 2YR colleges increased 0.6% from FA21 to FA22 nationally; During the same time, it increased 5% at CCC, and is up another 16% this fall.
- Latinx male student enrollment increased by 6% nationally from FA21 to FA22; During the same time, it increased 10% at CCC, and is up another 9% this fall.



Enrollment for Black and Latinx Female students also increased in the last year, outpacing state and national trends




- Black female student enrollment at public 2YR colleges decreased 1.9% from FA21 to FA22 nationally; During the same time, it increased 7% at CCC, and is up another 9% this fall.
- Latinx female student enrollment increased by 1.7% nationally from FA21 to FA22; During the same time, it increased 1% at CCC, and is up another 6% this fall.

# The Chicago Roadmap strategy continues to increase Early College enrollment




#### Early College YoY Change Fall 2022 to Fall 2023


At all colleges offering adult education, adult education headcount increased by 20% or more.

### City Colleges is rebounding from a pandemic enrollment decline





#### **Credit Unduplicated Headcount by Home College**




#### **Credit Hour Production by Course College**



### **Strategies**

### CCC gains stem from a combination of factors including a reenvisioned enrollment strategy and key investments

#### Re-envisioned enrollment strategy and investments

- Strategic enrollment management
  - Metrics & data, capacity building, norming, and review
- Marketing investment
  - 3X increase in marketing spend since FY20, 16% ad spend increase FY22 to FY23
- Chicago Roadmap
  - 18 Post-secondary navigators supporting 84 high schools, transitional math and English and early college significant enrollment growth, model pathways in in-demand fields
- Financial access scholarships, grants and waivers
  - Doubled the investment in free college over the last six years to \$21M in FY23
  - No increase in tuition credit hour rate since 2016.
