THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreements, to authorize the execution of an agreement with Gideon Taylor for the license and implementation of GT eForms and WebUX to develop a student-centered enrollment system for Continuing Education commencing no sooner than December 5, 2024 and continue for one (1) year after such commencement date at a total cost not to exceed \$530,000.

TERM:

The term of this agreement shall begin on no sooner than December 5, 2024 and continue for one (1) year after such commencement with the option to renew for one (1) additional two (2) year period.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Gideon Taylor shall provide and implement GT eForms and WebUX software solutions to facilitate continuing education enrollment at City Colleges of Chicago. The solution shall include user-friendly enrollment forms within PeopleSoft, single-session student enrollment capabilities, dynamic course search functionality, marketing content integration, and direct course enrollment links from external marketing materials. The implementation shall enable students to self-enroll in continuing education courses through an intuitive interface while maintaining full integration with CCC's existing PeopleSoft Campus Solutions system. The scope includes all necessary software licenses, implementation services, configuration, testing, and training to ensure successful deployment of both GT eForms and WebUX products.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The implementation of Gideon Taylor's GT eForms and WebUX solutions will significantly improve CCC's continuing education enrollment process by addressing critical operational inefficiencies. This solution will substantially reduce staff time currently spent on manual enrollments, decrease course cancellation rates, and generate additional revenue through projected enrollment increases. The

system will enable students to self-enroll through an intuitive interface. Furthermore, the solution will enhance CCC's ability to deliver on grant program commitments, expand partnerships with industry leaders, and rapidly respond to emerging workforce development needs. By streamlining the enrollment process and enabling direct marketing capabilities, CCC will strengthen its position as a leader in workforce development while better serving both students and industry partners through improved accessibility and efficiency of continuing education programs.
