The term of the purchase shall commence on December 5, 2024, and ends on June 30, 2025.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Two Kits that serve the Automotive Program

T7800 CERTIFICATION KIT: The T7800 is a machine with advanced features that allow technicians to mount and demount tires at a stunning pace with minimal fatigue and reduced chance of wheel damage.

TPMS5 CERTIFICATION KIT: The Snap-on Tire Pressure Monitoring Systems 5 (TPMS5) is a tire diagnostic tool/equipment that helps users to diagnose, service, and program sensors and vehicles.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The automotive technology program and related accessories, installation, and associated services will provide the City Colleges of Chicago student body the opportunity to gain technical and practical experience in an effort to foster and encourage critical thinking, problem-solving skills, and creativity.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Snap-On Industrial, a Division of IDSC Holdings LLC was awarded in accordance with the procurement procedures as detailed in Sourcwell (formerly National Joint Powers Alliance) contract 121223-SNP approved under Board Report #29816 and #32583 and gives access to goods and services. Pursuant to State law, contracts for goods and services procured from another governmental entity are exempt from the District’s competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and recommends a full waiver of the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan due to the nature of the purchase (tire certification kits) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General’s authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board’s Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
