RESOLUTION

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS CHICAGO (UIC) FOR THE CCC ADULT EDUCATION ILLINOIS HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA RECOGNITION CEREMONY ADULT EDUCATION DISTRICT WIDE

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220 et seq., as amended, authorizes public agencies to enter into agreements and contracts to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking authorized by law upon approval of their respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, UIC is the selected venue for the 2024 Adult Education Illinois High School Diploma Recognition Ceremony, which is the event to celebrate the CCC Adult Education students who earned their official GED or HiSET certificate.

WHERAS, UIC has agreed for this event to be a partnership between CCC and UIC, which will involve the Chancellor of UIC speaking at the event to motivate the CCC students. UIC is the selected venue because we have outgrown the capacity to host this at a CCC location due to an increase in graduates and family members of graduates being able to attend this event. UIC reduced the price of using the space because the event will be a partnership opportunity between UIC and CCC. Overall, UIC Forum offered the best price to meet the date and size of this event.

WHEREAS, for the event UIC has agreed to provide the venue on Saturday, June 15, 2024. We will have access to the space from 8 am to 4 pm, which includes enough time for set-up and take-down. This space comes with the stage and chairs needed, an area for students and staff to prepare, and all auxiliary staff and equipment to make the venue turn-key.

WHEREAS, CCC Adult Education will use this event to celebrate this major milestone for our Adult Education students. The event also serves as a recruitment event for families and friends of the graduates who may also be in need of Adult Education or Credit classes. The ceremony, in partnership with UIC, will also motivate the graduates to continue on their credit and career pathways, increasing their economic mobility.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such an agreement, to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with UIC to host the Adult Education High School Recognition Ceremony and provide parking vouchers for graduates and their families on Saturday, June 15, 2024 at a total cost not to exceed \$28,500.
