THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair to exercise the option to renew the agreement, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreements, to execute an amendment to our agreement with Fooda, Inc. to provide Food2You Maplewood, Inc. childcare meals to Daley College, Malcolm X College, Olive-Harvey College, Truman College and Kennedy-King College for the period commencing no sooner than May 3, 2024 through May 2, 2025, at a total cost not to exceed \$560,000.

TERM:

The term of the agreement shall commence on May 3, 2024 and will continue through May 2, 2025.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Fooda, Inc. will continue to provide childcare meals services for breakfast, lunch, and snacks to the following child development laboratory centers:

Daley College, Malcolm X College, Olive-Harvey College, and Truman College.

Additionally, childcare meal services are needed for the Kennedy-King College child development laboratory center during kitchen staff vacations.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

These services will ensure the childcare meals provided to CCC child development laboratory schools are compliant with Illinois State Board of Education - Child and Adult Care Food Program requirements.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

CCC is seeking Sole Source exemption for Fooda to provide meals to the Child Development Lab Schools because they hold an active contract, license, and exclusive rights to the CCC’s kitchen space. Sharing the licensed kitchen space with another vendor could be challenging and 2 disruptive to the food programs. Fooda provides a full-service meal program to the Child Development Lab Schools. Further, during the previous award, bidders declined to accept Childcare food services without being awarded the larger food service contracts. Fooda is best-equipped to serve as the sole provider for childcare meals.

Additionally, ISBE has approved CCC sole source process and to proceed with Fooda (Food2You) in providing these services. Overall, Fooda is licensed to provide CCC with cafeteria, catering, vending and childcare meals to CCC and is best equipped to be the Sole Source vendor for childcare meals.

In accordance with the sole source policy procedures, this is exempt from the District’s competitive bidding process.

In addition, each year, Fooda is required to submit a price for the meals and the price cannot exceed the Consumer Price Index. Following are the new prices:

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
