TERM:

The term of this agreement shall begin on November 8, 2024, and shall end on June 30, 2025.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Grainger will serve as the vendor responsible for providing the Culinary and Automotive equipment required for Kennedy-King College's educational programs. Their services will include the procurement and timely delivery of high-quality, industry-standard equipment that meets the specific needs of both the Culinary Arts and Automotive departments. Grainger will also ensure that the equipment complies with all safety and operational standards, contributing to the hands-on learning experiences essential for students in these technical fields. Additionally, Grainger will offer ongoing customer support, including product guidance and assistance with any maintenance or replacement needs, ensuring that the equipment remains fully functional and up to date throughout its lifecycle.
