

- In 2015, Wright College piloted a selective guaranteed admission program to The Grainger College of Engineering at UIUC – Engineering Pathways
- In 2018, obtained the NSF HSI research grant "Building Bridges into Engineering and Computer Science"
- In 2019, Offered the 1st Engineering Bridge with 32 participants and Launched the Illinois Tech Guaranteed Admission Program (GAP)
- In 2020, Wright College became CCC's Center of Excellence for Engineering and CS due to the frameworks developed through the NSF funded grant.

NSF-2019 Cohort (1st Bridge)











Program Enrollment
