AGREEMENT

THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

That the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreement, to authorize the execution of an agreement with Anatomage, Inc, to provide equipment needed to facilitate students in CTE training in Health Science and Career Programs from April 3, 2025 through June 30, 2025 at a total cost not to exceed \$99,945.

TERM:

The term of the purchase shall begin on April 3, 2025, and shall end on June 30, 2025.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The equipment being procured is an Anatomage visualization table, a 3D digitalized convertible table designed to enhance learning and practical application in Anatomy and Physiology. This acquisition supports Career and Technical Education (CTE) programming by providing advanced visualization capabilities, including the ability to study disease processes in a highly interactive format.

The package includes the 3D digitalized convertible table, a protective table covering, online support services, cloud capability with unlimited data access, on-site training by Anatomage, Inc. representative and shipping and handling. Advanced features include tools such as Stroke Map, 12-lead ECG, Wiggers Diagram, viewable myocardial infarctions, Bronchoscopy, and access to common clinical injection procedures. The purchase also comes with an extended two-year warranty to ensure ongoing functionality and support. Software updates for the life of the machine are included.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The components provided are essential for improving the teaching and learning of anatomy and physiology in the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Health Science and Career Programs at Malcolm X College (MXC). The Anatomage, the provider of advanced 3D digital learning technology, has been selected as the vendor due to its ability to deliver and support this state-of-the-art educational tool. Anatomage table will be integral to CTE Programs of Study (POS) at Malcolm X

College, including Sterile Processing, Medical Assisting, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Phlebotomy, Radiography, and Mortuary Science. This advanced technology enables MXC to elevate the quality of education offered in its Virtual Hospital/Simulation Center, supporting the integration of cutting-edge tools for students to develop and practice skills in a risk-free environment.

The device will play a critical role in meeting the specialized accreditation and skill competency resource needs of CTE programs. All Perkins Programs of Study will benefit from the device's capacity to reinforce foundational knowledge of human anatomy and physiology, a cornerstone of healthcare education.

By integrating academic coursework with technical skill development, this technology bridges classroom learning with the clinical and workplace experiences CTE students will encounter, preparing them for successful careers in healthcare.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

In accordance with sole source policy procedures, this service is exempt from the District's competitive bidding process.
