that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreements, to execute an agreement with Fooda, Inc. to provide Food2You Maplewood, Inc. childcare meals to Daley College, Malcolm X College, Olive-Harvey College, Truman College and Kennedy-King College for the period commencing no sooner than May 3, 2025 through May 2, 2026, at a total cost not to exceed \$500,000.

#### TERM:

The term of the agreement shall commence on May 3, 2025, and will continue through May 2, 2026.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

Fooda, Inc. will continue to provide childcare meals services for breakfast, lunch, and snacks to the following child development laboratory centers: Daley College, Malcolm X College, Olive-Harvey College, Kennedy King College and Truman College.

#### BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

Services provided will ensure the provided childcare meals to CCC child development laboratories are compliant with Illinois State Board of Education - Child and Adult Care Food Program requirements. During the previous award, bidders declined to accept Childcare food services without being awarded the larger food service contracts. Fooda is best- equipped to serve as the sole provider for childcare meals. Additionally, ISBE has approved CCC sole source process and to proceed with Fooda (Food2You) in providing these services. Overall, Fooda is licensed to provide CCC with cafeteria, catering, vending and childcare meals to CCC and is best equipped to be the Sole Source vendor for childcare meals. In addition, each year, Fooda is required to submit a price for the meals and the price cannot exceed the Consumer Price Index. The prices below are the new prices:

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
