THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreements, to authorize the execution of an agreement with Pace Systems, Inc. and CDW-Government, LLC (“CDW-G”), for the purchase of computer technology equipment and services for use by Harold Washington College, for the period commencing no sooner than February 6, 2025 through June 30, 2025, with Pace Systems, Inc. up to \$35,625 and CDW-G up to \$54,358.03 and at a total cost not to exceed \$89,983.03.

TERM:

The term of this agreement shall commence no sooner than February 6, 2025, and shall end on June 30, 2025.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Pace Systems, Inc. and CDW-G will sell various computer technology equipment and related services to Harold Washington College. Products and services include laptops, Chromebooks, specialized thermal imaging cameras, monitors, iPads, accessories, and extended service agreements for certain hardware.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

This solution will authorize Harold Washington College to order a wide range of IT equipment that is essential to supporting technology-enabled classrooms, labs, libraries, and other learning spaces, as well as the overall operation of the college. The IT products and related services will be purchased at the best available cost-based pricing which will include manufacturer's discounts, educational software, and volume discount incentives.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

The vendors being utilized are part of our participation in various purchasing consortiums to leverage the aggregated purchasing power of the community colleges in Illinois.

Pursuant to Board Reports #29816 and #32583, the Board approved the use of the Illinois Higher Education Cooperative ("IPHEC").

Pace Systems, Inc. and CDW-G were awarded in accordance with the procurement procedures as detailed in RFP # IPHEC2011 (Computer Components, Networking, Supplies and Related Services), and D1702TMS (Microcomputer Systems, Products and Services) and approved under IPHEC purchasing consortium contracts.
