THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreements, to authorize the execution of an agreement with Seloc LLC for clean energy training for EV vehicles and infrastructure the period from June 5, 2025 to June 30, 2026, at a total cost not to exceed \$120,000.

TERM:

The term of this agreement shall begin on June 5, 2025, and shall end on June 30, 2026.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

SELOC is an organization that provides training services in the clean energy space. They have created training for level 1 to Level 10 EV installation training. SELOC provides an electronic method in which to share Program data with Institution. Such Program data may include training and testing materials, training and diagnostic aids, student tracking documentation, and operational guides and standards. SELOC has created a program where SELOC supports educational institutions in providing more accessible EVU technical training for vehicles manufactured by Universal EV charging manufacturers to assist in developing qualified entry-level technicians for EV charging station installation, maintenance and service and equipment repairs.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

City Colleges will have a state-of-the-art training plan by partnering with SELOC to prepare 100 EV charging installation technicians by June 2026. This training, which is completed in 14 weeks, allows the students hands-on training on how to install charging stations and connects the students to employment opportunities.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

In accordance with sole source policy procedures, this service is exempt from the district's competitive bidding process.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and recommends a full waiver of the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan due to the nature of the agreement (clean energy curriculum) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General- It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
