Wright College's initiatives will address the immediate needs of students experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity. Including, providing short-term emergency assistance (e.g., temporary housing vouchers, grocery gift cards), connecting students with community housing resources, and offering educational workshops on financial literacy and sustainable housing solutions. The program will also include a case management component to guide students through accessing local services and navigating systemic barriers.

The students can receive financial support to access temporary housing options. As evidenced by the HOPE

Survey, a significant number of students experience homelessness or are at risk for homelessness. Additionally, addressing students' basic needs may increase their capacity to remain in school and complete courses. This grant would be of importance to CCC for the institution to demonstrate its advocacy on behalf of its students. This tangible intervention can provide immediate and contribute to long term relief to students who express need for rapid rehousing.
