THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel to the legal form of such an agreement, to execute an agreement with SPAAN Tech, Inc. to provide architectural and engineering services for the renovation and expansion of the Dawson Technical Institute parking lot for the period from November 6, 2025, through November 5, 2028, at a total cost not to exceed \$786,692.50.

TERM:

The term of the agreement shall commence no sooner than November 6, 2025, and end on November 5, 2028, with the option to renew for an additional one (1) year period.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

SPAAN Tech, Inc. shall provide architectural and engineering services necessary for the renovation and expansion of the Dawson Technical Institute parking lot. Scope of work will include but is not limited to the re-configuring of the parking lot, the overhead electrical line worker and gas utility outdoor training areas, as well as other potential adjacent space to maximize the amount of available parking while maintaining space for these academic programs. Services will also include cost estimating, surveying, and environmental testing.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The Office of Administrative Services and Procurement Services has reviewed this request for services and has determined that it would be in the best interest of the District to purchase architectural and engineering services from SPAAN Tech, Inc, for the renovation and expansion

of the Dawson Technical Institute parking lot based on their experience with relevant projects. The existing parking lot and loading dock are in fair to poor condition. Renovating and expanding the lot will improve the overall condition of the facility, allow for more parking to meet current demands, and activate underutilized land.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to Board Policy, letter of interest, LOI# MWJ-DT2501 was posted publicly on February 6, 2025, on the CCC Bonfire portal and notifications were sent to all pre-qualified A/E firms (155) approved under Board Reports 34097 and 34924. Two firms submitted a qualification package on March 5, 2025: (1) Globetrotters Engineering Corporation and (2) SPAAN Tech, Inc.

Firms were evaluated based upon the following criteria:

- Prior performance of pre-qualified firm and its consultants, areas of expertise and including willingness to meet time and budget requirements
- Appropriate staff size including resumes of key personnel and disciplines of firm and consultants. A professional cost estimator is preferred.
- A narrative describing experience in related green infrastructure to address requirements of pre-qualified firms and their consultants with similar projects within the past five (5) years and project approach.
- Compliance with the CCC's Minority and Women Business Enterprise Commitment Participation Plan

From the responses submitted, SPAAN Tech, Inc. was selected as the most qualified to provide the services for this project based on its qualifications, experience with similar projects, and experience with higher education facilities. In accordance with state law, CCC negotiated pricing with SPAAN Tech, Inc., which submitted a pricing proposal of \$786,692.50. CCC has determined that the pricing proposal is in accordance with Capital Development Board guidelines, and the evaluation committee has determined that SPAAN Tech, Inc. best meets the needs of this project and of the City Colleges of Chicago.
