THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreement, to authorize the execution of an agreement with Elevate Healthcare, Inc on an as needed basis, for the purchase of computer hardware and software technology, high-mid fidelity simulators, medical equipment and services, various software licensing products, and related services for use by Malcolm X College from October 9, 2025 to June 30, 2027 at a total cost not to exceed \$413,431.04.

TERM:

The term of the agreement shall commence no sooner than October 9, 2025, and will continue through June 30, 2027.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Elevate Healthcare, Inc will sell various products and related services to Malcolm X College. Products and services include mannequins, Instructor laptops, tablets, task trainers, mannequin skin(s), SCE software, equipment and services, various software licensing products, as well as support services for certain hardware and technical services and sales support.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

Elevate Healthcare is the only vendor that offers Simulated Clinical Experiences (SCEs) for use with Lucina, Aria, EVO, and Lucina on the Maestro software. The copyrighted SCEs provide preprogrammed scenarios to run on the mannequin plus the following instructional content: synopsis, patient history, learning objectives, performance measures, facilitator notes and debriefing points. This solution will authorize Malcolm X College services that are essential to supporting the Simulation needs of students, faculty, and staff that support the overall operations of the college. The Simulation products and related services will be purchased at the best available cost, which will include manufacturer's discounts, educational software, and volume discount incentives.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

In accordance with sole source policy procedures, this service is exempt from the District's competitive bidding process.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and recommends a full waiver of the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan due to the nature of the agreement (medical simulation equipment & related services) and limited subcontracting opportunities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General- It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
