#### **THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:**

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreements to enter into an agreement with Pace Systems Inc for AV equipment and installation for the period from February 5, 2026, through June 30, 2026, at a total cost not to exceed \$157,000.

#### **TERM:**

The term of this agreement shall commence on February 5, 2026, and continue through June 30, 2026.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

Pace Systems, Inc will provide all labor, materials, equipment, programing, and project management necessary to deliver a complete, fully functional audiovisual system to several classrooms at Olive Harvey College Campus. The following services will be included: installing flat panels, projection screens, cameras, audio, and display mounting hardware. Configuration and programming of the integrated control system, touch panel interface, and wireless presentation capabilities. On-site union labor for installation, testing, and commissioning of all systems. Pace will include all manufacturer warranties with extended support plans as specified.

#### **BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:**

This purchase provides a turnkey, enterprise-grade audiovisual solution for several classrooms at the Olive-Harvey College campus that supports high-quality in-person, hybrid, and remote instruction. The upgraded system improves reliability, standardization, and ease of use by aligning with institutional AV technology standards while reducing downtime and support requirements. Professional installation, programming, testing, and project management are included to ensure compliance with operational and safety requirements and to deliver a fully functional system at turnover. The solution establishes a scalable, future-ready classroom environment that enhances instructional delivery, collaboration, and overall student and faculty experience.

#### **VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:**

The vendors being utilized are part of our participation in various purchasing consortiums to leverage the aggregate purchasing power of the community colleges in Illinois. Pursuant to Board Report #29816 and #32583, the Board approved the use of the Illinois Higher Education Cooperative (IPHEC).

Pace Systems, Inc and CDW-Government, LLC (CDW-G) were awarded in accordance with the procurement procedures as detailed in RFP # RM71017, (Software and Software Related Services) IPHEC 2011 (Computer Components, Networking, Supplies and Related Services), and D1702TMS (Microcom).
