**PURCHASE OF RADIOGRAPHY INSTRUCTIONAL EQUIPMENT FOR AN ENERGIZED LAB AND RELATED
SOFTWARE AND SERVICES**

THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreement, to exercise agreement with Henry Schein Medical, A Division of Henry Schein, Inc for radiography instructional equipment and related installation and support services for the period from July 9, 2026, through July 31, 2027, at a total cost not to exceed \$354,661.40 for the term of the agreement.

TERM:
The original term of this agreement commenced on July 9, 2026, and continued through July 31,2027.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The vendor will provide radiography equipment, software, and related services to support an energized instructional lab environment for the Radiography Program at Malcolm X College. The purchase includes:

- **12 RADMEDIX Acuity PDR Wireless Portable X-ray Systems** (2.0 kW generators with lithium-ion battery capability)
- **12 Acuity DR E-Series 14x17 wireless digital radiography detector systems with laptops and acquisition software**
- **AccuPACS web-based imaging storage and management system** with multi-user access and unlimited storage licensing
- Installation and configuration services, imaging software, and remote application support
- Manufacturer warranties, including multi-year detector coverage and system support

The equipment will be installed and integrated into existing lab infrastructure to create a fully functional energized radiography training lab that replicates current clinical imaging environments.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

This purchase strengthens City Colleges of Chicago by modernizing radiography instructional labs, ensuring students graduate with skills aligned to current clinical practice. It supports accreditation compliance, improves instructional efficiency and radiation safety, and enhances student readiness for employment in healthcare settings.

Additionally, leveraging existing infrastructure and a proven vendor relationship maximizes cost efficiency while minimizing operational disruption and long-term maintenance risk.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

In Board Report #29816 and #32583, the Board approved the participation in the use of OMNIA Partners (formerly U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance). Henry Schein, Inc. was awarded contract #2021002973 in accordance with the procurement procedures as detailed in RFP # 2018AO, (Medical and Surgical Supplies and equipment). Pursuant to State law, contracts for goods and services procured from another governmental entity are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and recommends a full waiver of the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan due to the nature of the agreement (purchase and installation of radiography instructional equipment) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
