**I. CALL TO ORDER BOND ISSUE NOTIFICATION ACT HEARING**

Chair Nuques called to order the February 5, 2026, Bond Issuance Notification Act Hearing to order.

**III. BOND ISSUE NOTIFICATION ACT HEARING**

Chair Nuques convened the Bond Issue Notification Act Hearing at 2:03 p.m. on February 5, 2026.

Chair Nuques stated that the purpose of the hearing was to consider the Board’s intent to sell General Obligation Alternative Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$180,000,000.

Chair Nuques noted that all persons desiring to be heard would have the opportunity to present written or oral testimony regarding the proposed bonds.

Chair Nuques stated that proceeds from the General Obligation Alternative Bonds would be used to finance the District’s capital improvement plans, including repairs and rehabilitation of existing buildings and facilities, as well as the acquisition of real estate and personal property, equipment, fixtures, and site improvements.

Chair Nuques then asked whether there were any comments from other members of the Board.

No comments were made.

Chair Nuques asked whether there was any written testimony to be entered into the record.

There was no written testimony.

Chair Nuques asked whether there was any oral testimony or public comment concerning the proposed bonds.

No oral testimony or public comment was offered.

Chair Nuques confirmed that all persons desiring to be heard had been given the opportunity to present oral and written testimony regarding the issuance of the proposed bonds.
