that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreement, to exercise an agreement with Snap-on Industrial, a Division of IDSC Holdings LLC, for installation and the purchase of various tools, supplies, kits and equipment to support instructional space improvement as part of Rev Up EV initiative, for the automotive program from March 5, 2026 through June 30, 2026, at a total cost not to exceed \$208,400.00.

TERM:

The term of this agreement shall commence on March 5, 2026, and continue through June 30, 2026.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Snap-on Industrial will provide required equipment and installation for a Build-A-Bay package, phase 3, to support the automotive technology programs at Truman College. The build-out will support classroom instruction and hands-on learning with updated tools, supplies, kits and equipment. Snap-on Industrial is part of the Sourcewell consortium contract. Please note pricing is based on the Sourcewell contract and includes delivery and off-load with CCC-approved purchase and installation for the following:

EV lab equipment
Vehicle diagnostics
Tool storage Power tool
Vehicle Tools control & asset management

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The development of this new EV lab will allow Truman College to offer the new EV course to our students. This space will be used to take apart high voltage batteries, electric motors, and electric drive units in a safe and secure location. This will also reinforce the learning of electric and hybrid vehicles.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to Board Reports #29816 and 32583, the Board approved the use of the Sourcewell, cooperative purchasing agreement. Snap-On Industrial was awarded in accordance with the RFP

procurement procedures and contract #121223. Pursuant to State Law, the purchase of goods and services from another governmental agency is exempt from the District’s competitive bidding requirements.
