


**Faculty Council Report**

*FC4 President’s Address for CCC Board of Trustees Meeting:*

Chairperson Nuques, Board of Trustees, Chancellor Salgado, Provost Potter, Student Trustee Widedji Deguenon, officers of the district, faculty, staff, students, community members, and beyond, greetings:

FC4 is beta testing a pivot to the following model for faculty council reports. This dashboard provides a snapshot of the FC4 cases based on their status as follows. The status distribution KPI metrics (i.e., the donut chart) show total cases, completed count, stuck cases, and in-progress items. The status distribution chart is color-coded with red as done (126 cases), blue as working on it (86 cases), green as not started (2 cases), and purple as stuck (2 cases). The priority breakdown (i.e., the horizontal bar chart) is organized by priority level: medium (60 cases), low (29 cases), high (65 cases), critical (60 cases), and no priority (2 cases) also known as “nice-to-haves” cases. This data articulates server-side aggregations that streamline counting items by status and priority—a technique that significantly improves performance by reducing data transfer and handling large datasets more efficiently.
