THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel as to the legal form of such agreement, to authorize the execution of an amended agreement to increase the amount with Henry Schein, Inc. to provide equipment and installation for the facilitation of the training of students in CTE Dental Hygiene clinic, from May 7, 2026 through August 30, 2026, at a total cost not to exceed \$76,000.

TERM:

The term of the purchase shall commence on May 7, 2026, and shall end on August 30, 2026.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The purchase and installation of two (2) dental chairs with necessary accessories to facilitate CTE programming in the Dental Hygiene clinic compatible with current dental clinic chairs. These chairs are being purchased from Henry Schein, Inc. and match the style and functionality of the other chairs in the clinic at MXC. The chairs (2) are the A-Dec 511 Chair, with the 332 Pro Trad Radius Delivery System, A-Dec 551 Asst instrumentation cluster, the A-Dec 574L LED Dental Light system, and the A-dec Doctors stool. The selected vendor will provide similar equipment for consistency in student exposure to equipment utilized in the workforce.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

These components are necessary for the procedures learned and performed in the Dental Hygiene CTE programming at MXC. The benefit of these chairs is to allow MXC to maintain class size as access to a dental chair is required for lab courses and public dental clinic. Without these chairs, we will need to reduce class size and community dental services.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

In Board Report #29816 and #32583, the Board approved the participation in the use of OMNIA Partners (formerly U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance). Henry Schein, Inc. was awarded contract #2021002973 in accordance with the procurement procedures as detailed in RFP # 2018AO, (Medical and Surgical Supplies). Pursuant to State law, contracts for goods and services procured from another governmental entity are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and recommends a full waiver of the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan due to the nature of the agreement (purchase of dental equipment) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
