APPLICATION FOR NEW PROGRAMS
PHLEBOTOMY BASIC CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, new educational programs require approval of the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508 and the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB); and

WHEREAS, an application for permanent approval of the City College of Chicago Phlebotomy Basic Certificate has been received and is under review by the Joint Curriculum Development Council for submission and

WHEREAS, the Phlebotomy program prepares students to collect blood specimens safely and accurately for laboratory testing, transfusion, and research. The curriculum includes venipuncture and capillary collection techniques, patient identification, infection control, specimen handling, and proper labeling and documentation and

WHEREAS, labor market data shows a strong demand for Phlebotomists in Cook County, with 400 projected annual openings over the next 10 years and median wages of \$48,063, annually. (Lightcast Q3 2026)

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois. Hereby approves the submission of the program for permanent approval by the Illinois Community College Board, pending completion of Proposed Academic Curriculum Changes (PACC) process per Academic Policy 9.02.
