CAMPUS IN HONOR OF CONGRESSMAN DANNY K. DAVIS**

WHEREAS, the City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) is committed to recognizing individuals whose contributions have significantly advanced education, equity, and community development in the City of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Danny K. Davis has served the 7th Congressional District of Illinois with distinction, representing the West Side of Chicago and advocating for education, health equity, criminal justice reform, and economic opportunity; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Davis began his career as an educator and community organizer, served as Alderman of the 29th Ward, and later as a Cook County Commissioner before being elected to Congress, demonstrating decades of public service rooted in the West Side community; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Davis has championed federal support for under-resourced colleges and led initiatives to improve educational outcomes for underserved populations; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Davis has taught at Malcolm X College and other institutions, and has been recognized for his contributions to education and public service; and

WHEREAS, the Community Center for Teaching and Learning at Malcolm X College West Campus serves as a hub for educational innovation, workforce development, and community engagement on the West Side of Chicago, aligning with Congressman Davis’s lifelong mission to uplift underserved communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 508, County of Cook and State of Illinois, hereby approves the naming of the Community Center for Teaching and Learning at Malcolm X College West Campus as the:
