THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

That the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreement, to execute an agreement with Oracle America, Inc., to provide software licenses and support maintenance services for various Oracle modules (listed in Scope of Services) commencing no sooner than September 3, 2026, for a period of one year, at a total cost not to exceed \$542,807.28 for the term of the agreement.

TERM:

The original term of this agreement shall commence no sooner than September 3, 2026, for a period of one year.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Oracle will provide software license support maintenance services to the District for various Oracle modules as follows:

- PeopleSoft Human Capital Management (Human Resources) - Used to maintain employee benefits, compensation, and other information in order to process, calculate, and produce paychecks for about 6,000 full-time and part-time employees
- PeopleSoft Financials and Supply Chain Management Licenses - Used to perform all major financial transactions to support CCC's annual budget
- PeopleSoft Campus Solutions (Student Information) - Used to maintain critical information for prospective and active students such as admissions, student finance, financial aid, records, enrollment, advising, completion, and compliance
- Oracle Database – Database environments used to store PeopleSoft application information
- PeopleSoft Interaction Hub (Enterprise Portal) - Provides a single area where Prospective Students, Faculty, Advisors, and Staff may access critical public and secured City College of Chicago (CCC) information and systems

- PeopleSoft User Productivity Kit (Change Management/Training Development Tool) - Used to develop electronic training materials for PeopleSoft and non-PeopleSoft applications

CCC currently holds 48,588 Oracle licenses based on the agreement approved by the Board on July 11, 2024 (Board Report No. 35177), covering each unduplicated full-time and part-time student, faculty, and staff at the campuses, with a contract term through June 30, 2027.

Student enrollment growth in FY2026 caused CCC's active student database record count to exceed the contracted license threshold, requiring the purchase of 4,362 additional Oracle licenses to remain in compliance with Oracle's license policies and business practices.

The total Oracle licenses required and requested are 52,950. This represents the current contracted baseline of 48,588 licenses plus the purchase of 4,362 incremental licenses attributable to FY2026 enrollment growth.

CCC is requesting the Board to approve the purchase of 4,362 additional Oracle licenses, bringing the total Oracle license count from 48,588 to 52,950.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

This solution will satisfy CCC's obligation to comply with Oracle's license policies and business practices and authorize CCC to continue its deployment of PeopleSoft application products in any configuration on an unlimited number of servers across the District's internet, intranet, and client/server environment.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

Pursuant to State law, all contracts for the purchase and delivery of data processing equipment, software and services are exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and recommends a full waiver of the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan due to the nature of the agreement (software licenses and support maintenance services for various Oracle modules) and the absence of subcontracting opportunities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to cooperate with the Inspector General for City Colleges of Chicago in any investigation conducted pursuant to the Inspector General's authority under Article 2, Section 2.7.4(b) of the Board Bylaws.

Ethics – It shall be the duty of each party to the agreement to comply with the applicable provisions of the Board's Ethics Policy adopted January 7, 1993, and as amended by the Board.

Contingent Liability – Pursuant to Section 7-14 of the Illinois Public Community College Act, all agreements authorized herein shall contain a clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
