THE CHANCELLOR RECOMMENDS:

the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chair, upon final approval of the General Counsel of the legal form of such agreement, to exercise an agreement with Anatomage, Inc for the purchase of a Visualization table for the period from September 3, 2026, through September 2, 2028, at a total cost not to exceed \$90,065.

ORIGINAL TERM:

The original term of this purchase commenced on September 3, 2026, and continued through September 2, 2028.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Harry S Truman College will procure the Anatomage Table, an advanced 3D anatomy and medical education system, to modernize laboratory classroom environments and enhance instructional delivery across Career and Technical Education (CTE) and STEM-aligned programs. The system utilizes digitized real human cadavers to provide an immersive, interactive, and technology-driven learning experience with +1500 case studies. The Science software will be able to accommodate experiments in Biology, Chemistry, and Microbiology, which will be useful in Biotechnology, Food Sciences, Water Resources, and Chemical Laboratory Technology programs.

The package includes the following components and services: Anatomage Virtual Cadaver Table and hardcover protective cover, tablet 4-pack bundles, science software, single teacher license, 1-year warranty and technical support, online training, and Table ON premium.

BENEFIT TO CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO:

The Anatomage Table is a state-of-the-art educational technology that transforms the teaching and learning of human anatomy through the use of digitized real human cadavers. Its implementation will significantly expand student access to high-quality, industry-relevant laboratory experiences while enhancing engagement and experiential learning. The technology aligns with current workforce

demands across biotechnology, environmental biology, chemistry, pharmaceutical sciences, healthcare, and other applied science fields. Furthermore, the Anatomage Table supports interdisciplinary learning across Career and Technical Education (CTE) and STEM pathways, strengthening students' technical competencies, improving learning outcomes, and enhancing workforce readiness for high-demand careers.

The Anatomage Table at Truman College presents a significant opportunity to strengthen the educational pipeline between Chicago Public Schools (CPS), an Early College Credit partner, and the City Colleges of Chicago (CCC). The Early College program expands access for high school students to dual credit and dual enrollment opportunities across CTE and STEM pathways, supporting the attainment of certificates, degrees, and industry-recognized credentials. By obtaining this advanced virtual anatomy technology, Truman will address the findings from the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA), to promote greater equity in CTE and STEM education. In addition, through Truman's participation in the Amgen Biotech Experience Grant and its ongoing collaborations with CPS teachers, the Anatomage Table can serve as a valuable recruitment and engagement tool, exposing high school students to innovative scientific learning experiences and encouraging their transition to CCC programs.

VENDOR SELECTION CRITERIA:

In accordance with sole source policy procedures, this service is exempt from the district's competitive bidding process.

MBE/WBE COMPLIANCE:

The Office of Procurement Services has reviewed the proposed compliance plan and has determined that the vendor has complied with the Board Approved MBE/WBE Contract Participation Plan with a recommended full waiver of the 7% WBE goal.
