NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Training Agreement (PD# 040421)

The District Office has entered into a training agreement with the City of Chicago, Department of Planning and Development, for \$16,060.00 to train up to 80 employees of The Chicago Department of Planning and Development to deliver effective presentations to diverse audiences utilizing multimedia. The performance period for this project is from March 8, 2004 through April 30, 2004.

Intergovernmental Agreement (PD# 040422)

The District Office has entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Chicago Mayor's Office of Budget and Management for up to \$300,000 to provide capacity building training to staff of delegate agencies of the City of Chicago to increase their capacity to deliver quality services to low and moderate income persons. The performance period for this project is from March 29, 2004 through December 30, 2004.

Wright College Receives Grant from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity

Business and Industry Services of Wright College submitted and received a grant from the Illinois Department of commerce and Economic Opportunity for the Employee Training Investment program for small to mid-sized companies.

That the funding source approved 88 courses and Wright College can receive up to \$176,957 for contract training and continuing education in those approved courses.
