that certificate and degree programs offered will be classroom and laboratory courses in sequence to provide the Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in General Studies, Associate in Engineering Science, Associate in Applied Sciences – Fire Science & Technology, and Associate in Applied Sciences – Criminal Justice; and

that City Colleges of Chicago through Harold Washington College will provide education support services, including qualified faculty, library support, registration and academic and financial aid advisement services for students as outlined in Part A of the MOU and that the United States Air Force will provide education support services, including classroom and administrative office space, tuition assistance and VA eduation benefits advisement to military students and other provisions as outlined in Part B of the MOU; and mutual provisions, including termination of the MOU by mutual agreement as long as notification is made by either party within 180 days of the date of termination, as outlined in Part C of the MOU; and
